

Small Animal/Cat Routine

6:30 am - 7 am

- 1) Small animal/Cat Chores.
 - a. Feed/water cats. Scoop litters (maybe vacuum if needed)
 - b. Turn reptile lights on and check waters (misting if needed)
 - c. Uncover Birds and check waters and seed
 - d. Turn music on and check temp of building

9:15 am - 9 :45 am Small animal/reptile and cat **pickups/drop offs**

Please try to not be late as it messes up all pet's playtime and can shorten the amount they get to play

- a. We do not mix these pets with other pets therefore we do not require them to be dropped off in the morning only like the dogs.
- b. Although your boarding reminder with say drop off is between 8-9 am it does say in fine print for small animals/cats to please keep the time we talked about.
- c. We prefer these pets to come during these times as before this we are busy with dog drop offs and these pets are in a separate building. At 9:30 we will be busy with the dog's introductions and hard to help late arrivals.

11 am - 2 pm

1. Fresh fruit/Veggies that owner provides to any small animal or bird
2. Feed crickets/worms/salad to reptiles (misting if needed)
3. Feed any cats that require lunch
4. Clean any cages (small animals, reptiles and birds)
5. Vacuuming, cleaning, dishes and scooping litters
6. Play times with photos taken (every 2-3 days posted on Facebook)
7. Outdoor deck time if pet is aloud, weather is good, and the pet is friendly with staff

2:30 pm - 3 pm Feed/water cats and scoop litters.

3 pm - 3:30pm Small animal/reptile and cat **pickups/drop offs**

6 pm - 8 pm

1. Pick up any uneaten wet food
2. Top up all waters
3. Scoop litters and take garbage out
